

4-H Event Scholarship Application

Logan County 4-H Council



Any youth who is enrolled in Logan County 4-H is eligible to apply for a \$100.00 scholarship to help aid the registration costs of attending any county, district, state or nationally sponsored 4-H event. If the event registration is less than \$100.00 the applicant may receive a scholarship worth 50% of the registration fee.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Applicants must have participated in and met the minimum sale goal of the current year's 4-H Council fundraiser. (4-H members who were not enrolled in Logan County 4-H at the time of the fundraising event may still apply for and receive a scholarship if the 4-H Council chooses to accept their application.)
- 2. Applicants must attend a Logan County 4-H Council meeting following their attendance of the 4-H event to give a short presentation about their experience.
 - a) Presentation aids such as a slide show presentation, short video, poster or notebook display, or event souvenir or memorabilia are encouraged but not required.
 - b) Examples of talking points may include: favorite part of the event, interesting skills or knowledge gained from the event, favorite speaker, etc.

All approvals or rejections of scholarship applications are at the discretion of the Logan County 4-H Council.
